



Responsibilities of the Region 11 International Tankard Committee

The BC portion of the International Tankard is the property of CurlBC Region 11. Region 11 Board of Directors are elected by the Curling Facilities of the Lower Mainland. One of the many duties of the Region Board of Directors is to appoint an International Tankard Committee.

Responsibilities of the Region 11 International Tankard Committee are:

- * Liaise with the WSCA International Tankard Committee (Washington State Curling Association).
- * Select Host Curling Facility through bid process (three years in advance).
- * Liaise with Host Curling Club Committee.
- * Provide Templates (see examples link on this web site) to Host Committee.
- * Provide the Draw suitable for 4 or 6 sheet curling rinks.
- * Maintain an inventory of International Tankard Crests.
- * Embroidery of year on International Tankard Crests (Fall).
- * Produce International Tankard Poster with pertinent information (Fall).
- * Distribute poster to CurlBC Communications Manager, Region 11 Secretary, Region 11 Delegates, Regions 8, 9, 10, 11 Curling Facilities. (October, with reminders in January).
- * Distribute Crests to participants via Region 11 delegates (February).
- * Distribute Crests to WSCA /Seattle Granite Club) and receive payment from WSCA for crests (prior to February).
- * At the January Region 11 meeting, select two participants from the Region 11 Representatives.
- * Deadline for registration is mid February.



- * Registration fees (\$100.00) from nominating Clubs to follow. To be payable to "CurlBC Region 11" and sent to the Region 11 Treasurer.
- * Maintain participant data list including contact information.
- * Assign participants to teams.
- * Ensure payment of \$2,700.00 to the Host Curling Facility to assist in covering ice, banquet and other costs.
- * Attend the International Tankard registration desk during the Meet and Greet on Friday at the Host Club.
- * Participate in Opening and Closing Ceremonies (ie speech, presentation).
- * Attend Banquet.
- * Establish a 3 year operational budget. Below, is the current 3 year budget.
